Described by Michael Billington in *The Guardian* as 'a beautifully written piece effortlessly linking the private and public worlds', *Touched* is set in Nottingham during the 100 days between VE and VJ days in 1945, and follows a family of women, and the few men left behind, as they try to adapt to the change that comes with the end of the war. Stephen Lowe's characters are gritty and bruised, struggling with the past and unable to grasp the future.
